Norwich great to explore by bike

The pace is right to spot a bargain in a quirky shop or pause for a chat with a friend in the park. The city is compact, making it manageable to ride from the edge to the centre in under 20 minutes. But you need to know where to go.

Welcome to the cycle network!

It features seven pedalways, each represented by a colour. Five cross the city from one side to the other and meet in the middle at St Andrews Plain. Two others encircle the city – orange near the centre and purple on the edge. They are complemented by neighbourhood routes that help you get around from your home to school and shops, or they can be connected to the pedalways for longer journeys. Norwich is yours to discover.

How to use this map

Planning your route

Use this side of the map for planning your route. It shows where the pedalways go and how they relate to facilities. The main routes are coloured and can be found on signs and stickers along the way.

Turn over to look at a detailed map of the city centre which features some of Norwich's finest buildings.

Route conditions

The quality of the network varies from place to place and we are implementing a long-term plan to improve it. The maps show the busy traffic areas and the traffic-free sections so you can match your route to your level of cycling confidence and skill. The traffic-free parts are usually shared with pedestrians so please be considerate and use a bell. Some parts of the network are privately owned and not maintained by the city or county council.
